- I. Call to Order at 10:02am. Five board member present. Diane Banks, Leif Lindbolm, Frank Rainey and Victoria Targosz were excused. Twenty-two stakeholders attended.

 - Treasurer Leonard Brockhahn budget approved

Saving \$18,217.00 Checking \$4,037.00 Membership dues \$1,420.00 Total \$23,674.00

- Endowment Fund- spendable amt. \$8,000.00
 - \$4,000.00 will be donated for the Oscoda Twp handicap access ramp project at Ken Ratliff Park.
 - Oscoda Trustee William Palmer stated the original grant was denied. Applied for a new grant. Possibly using American Rescue Plan money to fund the project. Framework might begin this fall after lake draw down.
- Weed Committee Leonard Brockhahn
 - Update on Summer Weed and Algae Treatment
 - First treatment was July 6. Next survey will be July 20-25. The next treatment will be the first part of August. Leonard will be on the boat with Clarke Co.
 - Stakeholder (Loud Dr. southeast) voiced concern about lack of treatment in that area, has a lot of weeds and string algae. Dan & Leonard explained the treatment process. Leonard stated a chemical SeClear is used to treat the algae. Leonard will review the area. Yearly spending cap for SAD is \$70,000. Rick stated we are in the second year of the current five year SAD.
- Membership Diane Banks- (Rick reported for Diane) We currently have over 300 members.
- Lake Monitor Dan Stock

Clarity is 5.6 ft which is down from an average of 6.4 ft over the past 10 years. Water temp average is 69 degrees.
